The idea here is that as you deacons grapple with what to do, lack of funds ought not to be the roadblock.

This is a pilot project, in which Diaconal Ministries Canada and World Renew are working with Canadian CRCs at the moment. Depending on the response, it may be broadened to include CRCs in the US.

We welcome your response to this. Should you want to apply for such a grant, please reply to this email, and we'll set the wheels in motion.
